Anyone found breaking these rules will face disciplinary action. Some teams will need to use coaches from other age groups within their clubs to allow games to be played this weekend.

**Club secretaries are well aware of who holds what so there will be no excuses.**

All coaches must on training and match days be wearing their FAW badges. If these are not received as yet, they are to carry the letters with them received from the FAW bearing FAW numbers.

League officials have to right to request to see these at games.
